You should avoid exposure to direct sunlight during treatment with voriconazole-containing medicinal products. It is important that you cover the areas of skin exposed to the sun and use sufficient sunscreen with a high sun protection factor (SPF), as an increased sensitivity of the skin to the sun's UV rays can occur. There is a risk that skin cancer could develop with prolonged use.

You should contact your doctor immediately if you experience:
Sunburn or severe skin reactions
after exposure to light or sun.

Ensure you undergo **all follow-up visits** for blood tests or skin evaluations arranged by your doctor.

Have a list of your other medications and medical conditions ready at each visit to a healthcare professional.

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
